Directions to Sponsoring Farms

Smoke Tree Farm: 8911 Plainville Road, Baldwinsville 13027

Take 690 West to 370 West. At light turn right onto Plainville Rd. Go 3 miles. Farm is on left, approximately 100 yards past Church Rd.

Bridle Path Manor: NYS Fairgrounds/4-H Rings

581 State Fair Blvd., Lakeland, NY 13209

Follow Route 690 to the Fairgrounds. Exhibitors taking the Thruway (Route 90) should use exit 39 and follow Route 690 East to the Fairgrounds. Show held at the 4-H rings.

Canterbury Stables: 4786 Roberts Road, Cazenovia NY 13035

From Syracuse & West: Take Rt. 20 East to Cazenovia. At Sunoco/Express Mart in Cazenovia, take left fork onto Fenner Rd. Go 1/4 mile; take first left onto Burton St. Go to end, farm straight ahead.

From the East: Rte. 20 West to Nelson. Turn right on Nelson Rd. Continue to stop sign, turn left onto Fenner Rd. Take second right onto Roberts Rd; farm is 1/4 mile down on right.

Follow Route 690 to the Fairgrounds. Exhibitors taking the Thruway (Route 90) should use exit 39 and follow Route 690 East to the Fairgrounds. Show held in the Coliseum.

Heritage Stables: 681 Franklin Street, Skaneateles, NY 13152

Take 690 East to Rt.5 East to Rt. 321 South. Go to end of Rt. 321, turn right onto Rt. 20 West. Turn Right onto Fuller St. (Fuller becomes Franklin St. Rd.) Farm is 1 Mile down on the right.

Classic Series General Rules

- 1. Rabies dated within 12 months & 2016/17 Coggins. Rabies & Coggins must be shown to office before numbers issued. CHS recommends horses receive new USEF requirements.
- 2. Check/Cash only accepted. \$50 surcharge for returned checks and/or accounts not settled in full at the horse show. All prize money will be awarded in office or deducted from show bill.
- 3. Adds/scratches for classes made in office prior to the start of the class.
- 4. If a horse is shown by multiple exhibitors, full stabling fees must appear on **one** entry. No partial payments for stabling/tack stalls.
- 5. Class fees waived for Lead line class.
- 6. NYS Fairgrounds (Empire Expo. Center), CHS Series LLC. & its members: Bridle Path Manor, Canterbury Stables LLC., Heritage Stables & Smoke Tree Farm will not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage incurred to riders, observers, horses or equipment brought to show.
- 7. Approved helmets **required** when mounted.
- 8. Classes may be divided, combined, relocated or cancelled at discretion of CHS committee.
- 9. Dogs must remain on leash at all times.

Coliseum Classic Rules

- 1. Stall fees must accompany entry form to receive discount.
- 2. Refunds available for scratched entries made before 7/31. After 7/31 NO refund on stalls plus \$15 office charge.
- 3. Stabling: All horses must purchase a box stall(s). Stall(s) purchased **before** 7/31 are \$75. **After** 7/31 are \$100. Tie Stall(s) \$35.
- 4. Day Stall(s) \$50. Horses may arrive 4 PM the day before they show & vacate upon completion of that day's schedule.
- 5. Non-showing horses will be charged \$50 in addition to the EMT/Insurance, Schooling & Stabling fees.
- 6. The following Health Requirements Must be met by all horses. A proof of a current Rabies administered within 12 mo. of coming to the grounds must be presented for each horse. HORSES STABLED IN NY STATE: Must present a Negative Coggins Test certificate dated in 2016 or 2017. HORSES STABLE OUTSIDE NY STATE: Must present a Negative Coggins Test certificate-dated since 8/11/16 and a Health Certificate-dated within 30 days of your arrival in NY State.
- 7. Horses may arrive after 2:00 PM Thursday. The Coliseum will be open for schooling over fences as follows:

Thursday	August 10	from 4:00 pm - 10:00 pm
Friday	August 11	from 5:00 am - 7:30 am
Saturday	August 12	from 5:00 am - 7:30 am
Sunday	August 13	from 5:00 am - 7:30 am

- 8. Management reserves the right to limit the number of horses in Coliseum at one time.
- 9. Lunging permitted in ring located BEHIND MAIN BARN ONLY.
- 10. Order form enclosed for bedding/feed through Mike Teske.
- 11. Camper hookups \$125.00. There will be a \$30.00 Fee per day/night for every vehicle parked on grounds in which someone is sleeping. This fee is charged even if the vehicle is not using hookup. Please go to office for parking information of horse trailers.

Farm and Coliseum Classic Divisions

*Lead line: Shown at walk and/or walk/trot. May not cross enter. *Maiden W/T (poles): Riders' 1st or 2nd yr. Showing W/T. Cross enter W/T only. *Walk/Trot (X-rails): Riders' 1st or 2nd yr. showing x-rails. X-rails ridden at trot. May cross enter Maiden W/T or Short/Long Stirrup. Short/Long Stirrup (x-rails): May cross enter w/t only. Simple changes allowed. Warm-Up Hunter 18"-2': Each horse/rider combination allowed 1 trip. Blue/Red Hunter: Score of 80+/Blue 75-79/Red. Any score below this receives no score. Scores announced, but no actual ribbon awarded. Open to all. May enter as many times as you would like before any hunter class, if schedule warrants.(not to include classic, handy & equitation classes.) Handy Hunter: May include halt, gallop, and or trot fence. Beginner Rider Eq./Hunter 18": Riders may not cross enter. Courses include change of direction & vertical jumps. Simple changes permitted. Novice Rider Eq./Hunter 2': Not won 3 blue's at 2' prior to 12/1/16. Children's Pony Eq./Hunter 2': Open to Junior's. Schooling Hunter 2': Open to all. Baby Green Hunter 2': Horses/ponies in 1st or 2nd yr. of showing at 2'. Special Hunters 2'3": Open to all. Limit Rider Eq./Hunter 2'3": Not won 6 blue's at 2'3" prior to 12/1/16. **Open Equitation <u>2'6''</u>**: Open to all horses/ponies & non-prof. riders. -CHS Mini Medal: Top 4 riders return for additional testing. -Mini Maclay: At discretion of judge, riders may test on the flat. -Child/Adult Medal: Test on course Pre-Child/Adult Hunter 2'6": Open to all horses/ponies & non-prof. rider Low Hunter 2'9"-3': Open to all. **Pleasure Horse/Pony Under Saddle:** Hunter Pleasure: Judged on ability to give a pleasurable ride.

Bridle Path Hack: May be asked to extend the trot, stand quietly on a loose rein, halt & back.

<u>Conformation Hunter U/S</u>: After working both directions, horses will be shown on the line. Riders may have one groom to assist.

*Classes may be split to accommodate sharing of horses.

Coliseum Classic Only Additional Classes

Pleasure Horse/Pony Under Saddle:

<u>Good Strides Challenge</u>: Emphasis on manners & performance.
Proceeds to "Equine Services for Heroes." Trophy & 6 ribbons.
<u>CHS Hunter U/S Classic</u>: Child/adult riders only. At judges discretion the top 8 may be asked for additional work. If 8 or more compete, prize money as follows: \$150, \$100, \$75, \$25.
Modified Hunter 2'6'': Open to all.

*<u>M&S Child/Adult Medal 2'6''</u>: Test on course.

*<u>M&S Bit O' Straw Hunter Classic 2'6'' & CHS Classics 18'' & 2'</u>: Horses/ponies may compete once in each class with non-prof. rider. Classic runs as 2 rounds. Horse/pony must have entered & shown in 2 classes over fences at show. Top 8 called back for 2nd round. Scores from both rounds determine placing. If tie, the winner is determined by

score of 2nd round. If 8 or more compete, prize money as follows:

\$150, \$100, \$75, \$25. 8 ribbons awarded in each class.

Classic Horse Show Series Point Policy

<u>Ring A</u>

Hunter division: points to horse. Equitation division: points to rider. Points: 10, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3. 6 ribbons in following divisions at all shows: Schooling Hunter, Baby Green Hunter, Special Hunter, Limit Rider, Open Equitation, Pre-Children's/Adult Hunter, Low Hunter & Horse/Pony Pleasure U/S.

<u>Ring B</u>

Points awarded to rider. Points: 10, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. 8 ribbons in following divisions at all shows: Lead line, Novice Rider, Children's Pony Rider, Beginner Rider, Walk/Trot, Short & Long Stirrup, Maiden Walk-Trot.

Division Champion/Reserve Tie Breaker

At individual shows, the winner is determined by accumulation of most points over fences in that division. If tie still exists it will be broken by a coin toss. In case of tie for year end, winner determined by points accrued at Coliseum Classic. Ties for other than Champion/Reserve will remain tied.

Miscellaneous

- Following classes do not count toward year end division championships: Blue/Red, Warm Up, M&S Classes, Modified Hunter,18" & 2' Hunter Classics.
- In **Ring A**, the same **horse & rider combination** must attend 3 of 5 shows in the series to qualify for Year End Awards.
- In **Ring B**, **riders** must attend 3 of 5 shows in the series to qualify for Year End Awards.
- At year end banquet, special award given to riders with perfect series attendance.
